## **BOTHAM EVENT CHAMPIONSHIP**

The Botham Event is not a complete round robin because we have 13 teams and 9 draw weeks. Therefore 9 teams will have a bye week and curl 8 weeks and 4 teams will curl 9 weeks. The unbalanced and uneven schedule could lead to some very complex ways to determine a champion. Ice availability is very limited so please try to avoid any “make-up” games.

We will use the Mansfield Event tiebreaker criteria to determine the event winner. The Mansfield Event tiebreaker information will be posted on the Mansfield Event schedule board. We will follow the criteria with two modifications described below.

A team with a full game or more lead after the schedule will be declared the champion. Teams within one half game of each other will be considered “tied”. If one team finishes with a 9-0 record, they would be “tied” with a team with an 8-0 record. A 9-0 team versus an 8-1 team is not considered tied because they are separated by one full game. If we have a 9-0 team, an 8-0 team and an 8-1 team the 8-1 team is not “tied” with the other two as they are one full game behind the 9-0 team.

The tiebreakers to be used after determining the teams that are “tied” are as follows:

1. All undefeated teams will playoff for the event championship assuring that if you win all your games you will win the event.
2. Head to Head competition, assuming all involved “tied” teams have played each other.
3. Strength of Opponents. The team with opponents with the highest winning percentage will be declared the winner. Games not yet played and recorded for opponents will not be included.
4. Record for the last 5 games of the season, then the last 6 games, then the last 7 games, etc.
5. If two teams are still tied at this point a playoff game will be necessary and must be scheduled the week following the end of the regular season play. In the Mansfield Event tiebreaker this step would be a coin flip instead of a playoff game.
